City Facilities Closed During the Holidays

City of San Mateo facilities will be closed from Monday, December 26 through Monday, January 2 in observance of the holidays as well as cost savings measures including staff furloughs. Affected facilities include City Hall, the Main Library and branch locations, Japanese Tea Garden, and recreation centers and Senior Center with no services provided at these facilities during this closure. In addition, the Main Library and branch locations will also be closed the week of December 18 and the Japanese Tea Garden will be closed beginning on December 24.

The City's public safety and emergency services will not be affected by this closure as fire stations, the police station, and other emergency service facilities will remain open during this time.
