Since 2016, we have been working collaboratively with your community to achieve street safety measures in your neighborhood. Your engagement on our collective Traffic Action Plan helped to prioritize what matters to you most.

The Parrott Drive Intersection Improvement was just one of those priorities. Your feedback in our recent mail-in survey, allows us to now proceed to the next phase, and also move on to the other nine priorities that you have outlined for us.

Thank you to all who participated in the mail-in survey. We received a great response and valuable insight about the values your community puts on neighborhood aesthetics, traffic flow and bicycle and pedestrian safety.

Support for safety improvement - 64 %

Remove the Pilot until installing Phase 1 - 9%

Remove the Pilot, don't install Phase 1, wait to fund final design - 18%

Leave Pilot in place until Phase 1 - 37%

Restore the Intersection as it was - 36%

## DEAR NEIGHBORS,

Thank you Baywood neighbors for taking the time to return your Parrott Drive Survey response card.

We are now moving into Phase 1 of the Parrott Drive Intersection Improvement project, as encouraged by you, and expect to be replacing the white posts with planter boxes in the next six months. We will also now seek funding for the final design.

This safety improvement is one of the ten safety priorities your neighborhood had asked us to achieve when we started the Traffic Action Plan in Baywood in 2016.

We thank you again for your commitment to your neighborhood. You can expect to see construction postcards once the date of Phase 1 next steps are finalized.
