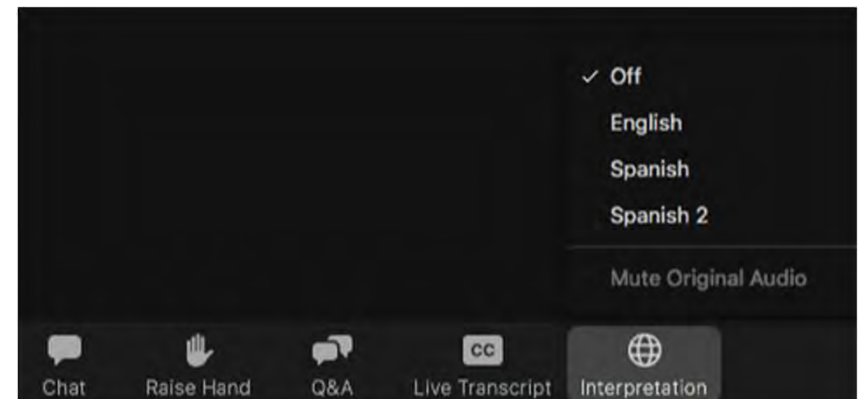

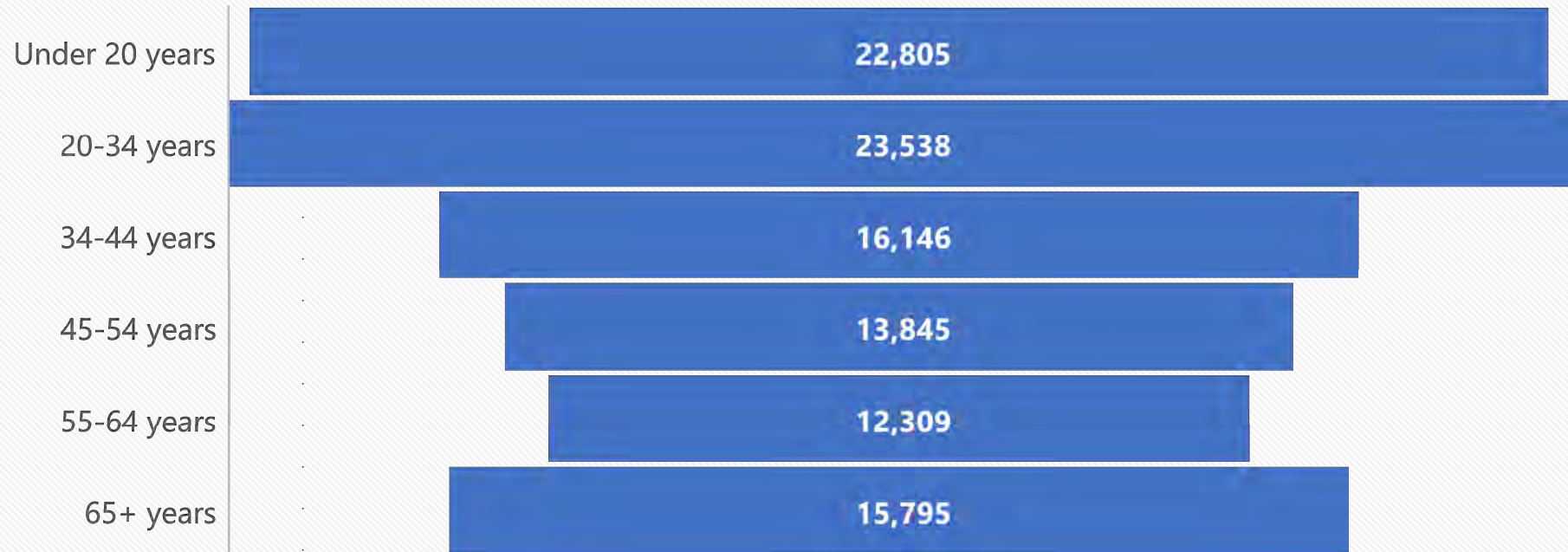

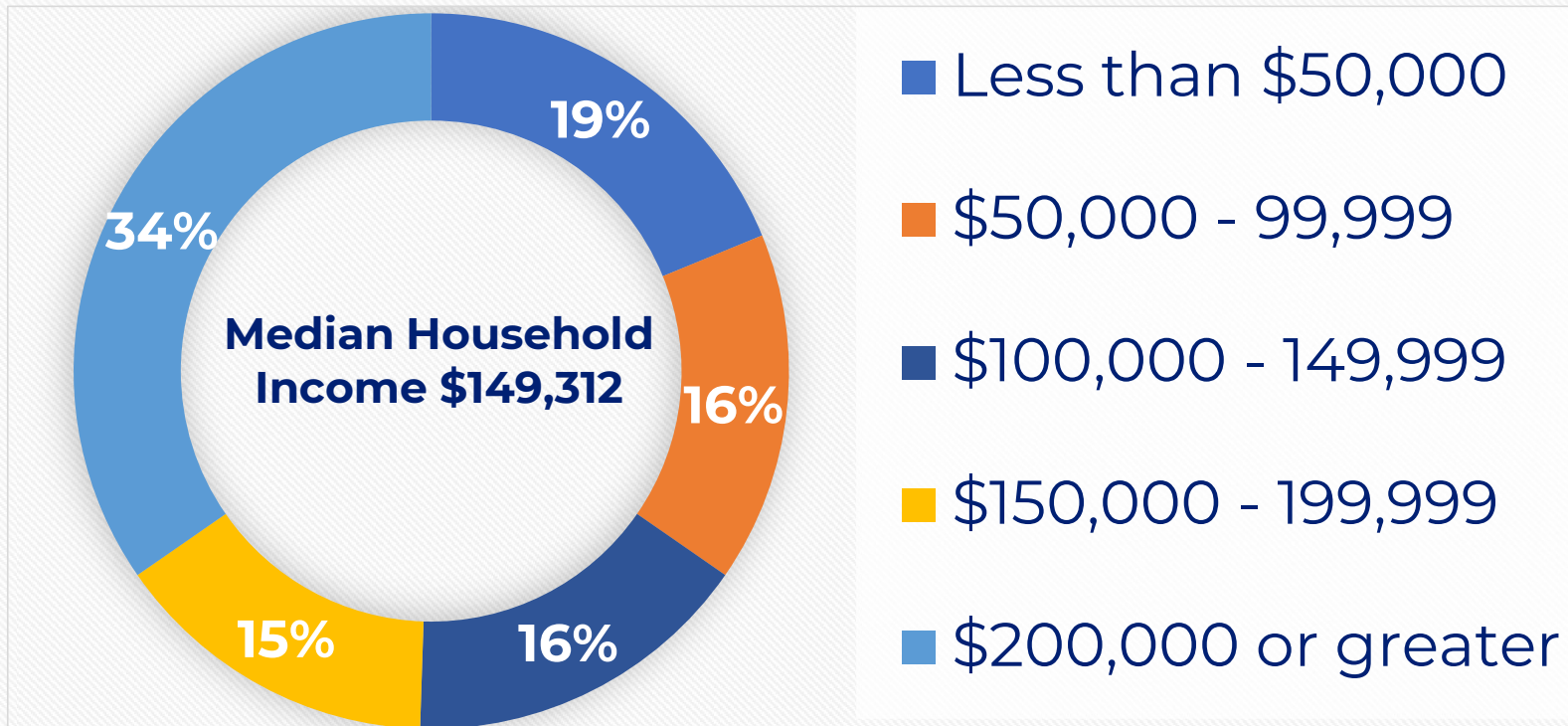
Who Lives Here?

Median Age 37.2



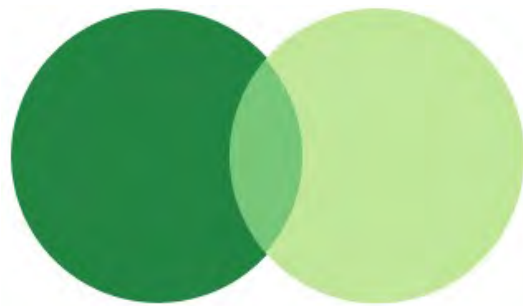

Household Incomes



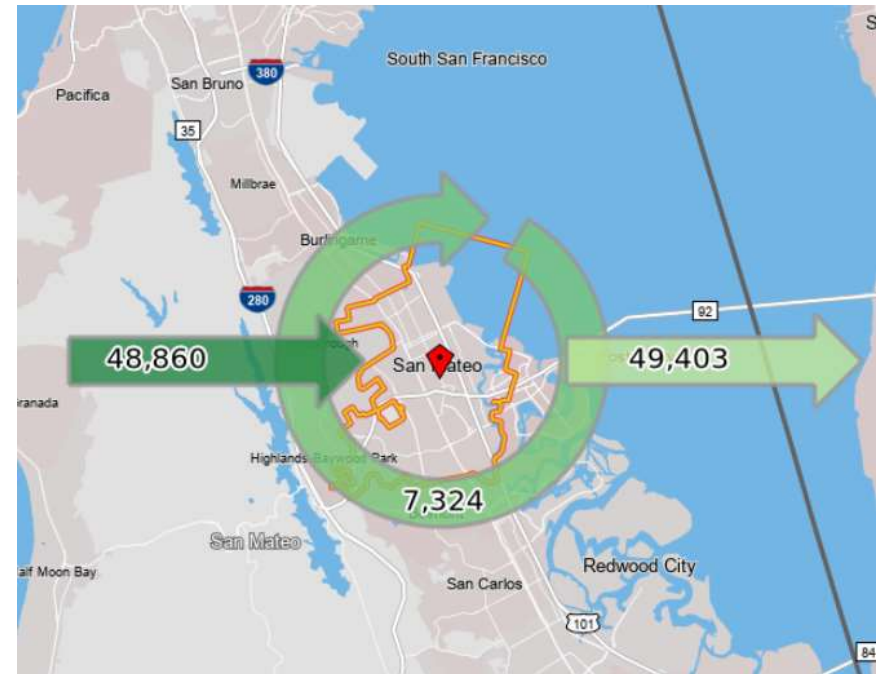

Where People Live vs. Work



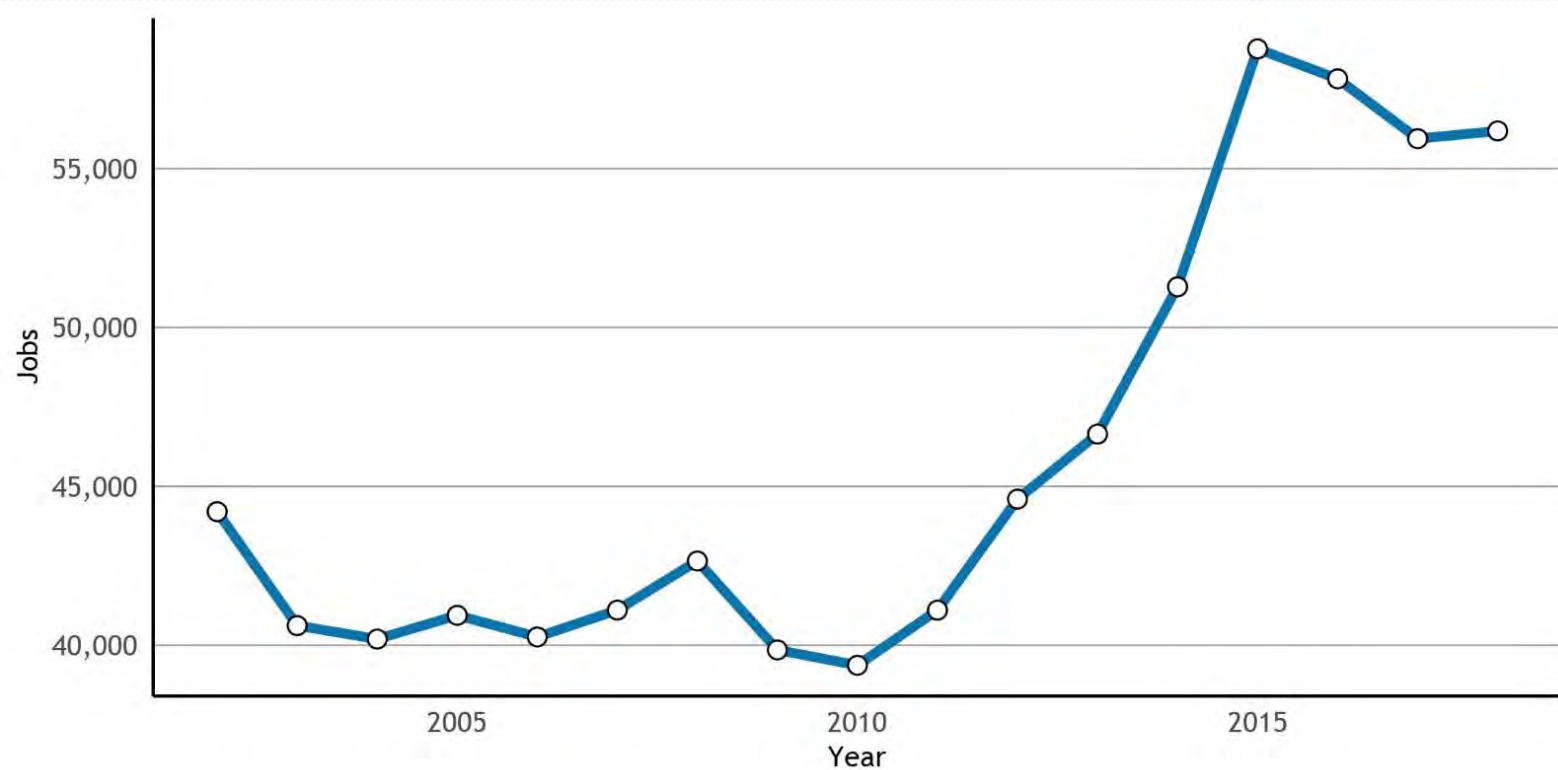
48,860 – work in San Mateo, live outside

- Capacity to accommodate RHNA -7,015
- Programs / Policies to support Housing at all income levels
- Programs/ Policies to ensure inclusion of all residents (Fair Housing)

- Inclusionary Requirements/ Below Market Rate (BMR) Program and Density Bonus
- Commercial Linkage Fee
- Local funding to support affordable housing

Mixed Use

- Mix of uses in one building or development
- Increases walkability



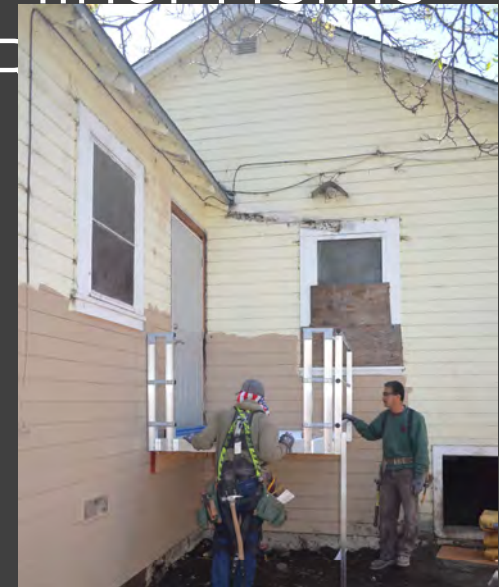
Transit Oriented Development

- Compact housing, jobs, shopping
- 1/4 to 1/2 mile from public transit

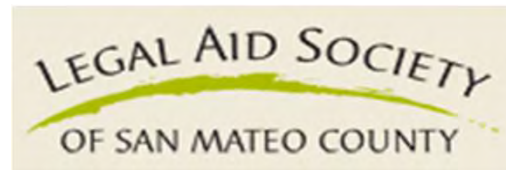

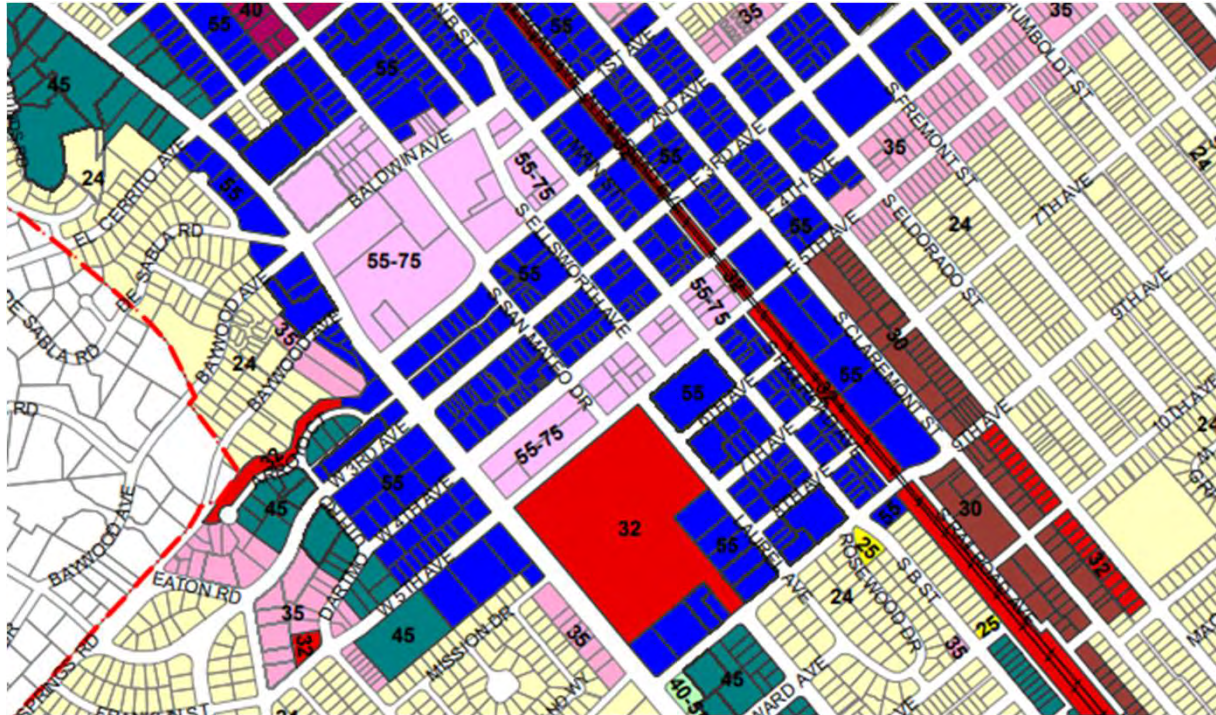
