City of San Mateo Celebrates Earth Day with Family-Friendly Activities, Events

San Mateo, CA – Celebrate Earth Day and learn how you can support the environment by joining the City of San Mateo's new series of sustainability programs and workshops during April and May. This Earth Day, the City will host in-person workshops and programs that include interactive activities for all ages.

There are dozens of free, family-friendly programs that will inspire participants of all ages to take action to reduce waste, save money and reduce their impact on the environment. The City has ambitious goals established in the City's Climate Action Plan to reduce greenhouse gas emissions and Earth Day is a great time to highlight how we can make a difference on the local level. The sustainability-focused series includes lessons on how to repair household items instead of sending them to landfills, tips for electrifying your home, how to mend clothes, compost giveaways and seed library, food sovereignty and habitat creation, a zero-waste cooking lesson and more!

San Mateo's Earth Day series includes more than a dozen events and kicks off April 1 with a Fixit Clinic and culminates May 20 with the unveiling of a new seed library. Other programs include a compost giveaway, recycling and e-shred event, family gardening workshops, clothes mending lessons and more.

The City of San Mateo Public Library was one of the first in California to receive a new sustainability grant to encourage educational programming in the community.
