

ARUGULA: Bellezia
Diplotaxis tenuifolia

Wild arugula, deep green color.

- Direct sow, full sun to part shade
- Plant 1/8" deep, 5 seeds per ", rows 2" apart
- 35-51 days to maturity, depending on desired leaf size
- Annual

BEAN: Tavera
Phaseolus vulgaris

Bush beans; short fancy pods 4-5 inches long. A standard in filet beans! Pick when slender.

- Full sun
- Direct sow into ground after last frost
- Plant 1" deep, 2" apart, rows 20-36" apart
- Plant height 2'
- 54 days to maturity

BEET: Gourmet Blend
Beta vulgaris

Three types of beets: Detroit Dark Red, Chioggia, and Golden.

- Full sun
- Plant in cool season, direct sow
- Plant 1/2" deep, 20" apart
- Plant height 20"
- 65 days to maturity

BOK CHOI
Brassica rapa subsp. chinensis

- Full/partial sun
- Direct sow into ground
- Plant 1/4" deep, 2" apart, rows 12" apart
- Plant height 20", 20" wide
- 35-60 days to maturity

CARROT: Danvers 126

Daucus carota

6 to 7-inch sweet carrots.

- Full sun
- Plant in cool season, direct sow
- Plant 1/4" deep, 2-3" apart
- Plant height 4-8"
- 75 days to maturity

**CUCUMBER: Cool Customer**

Cucumis sativus

Rugged, blocky, crunchy cucumber, 4-5 inches long.

- Full sun
- Direct sow when soil is 70 degrees or sow indoors 3-4 wks before transplanting
- Plant 1/2" deep, 1 foot apart, rows 6" apart
- 55 days to maturity

**CUCUMBER: Lemon**

Cucumis sativus

Small, rounded, pale yellow crunchy cucumbers; not bitter.

- Full sun
- Direct sow when soil is 70 degrees or sow indoors 3-4 wks before transplanting
- Plant 1/2" deep, 2 seeds per foot, rows 6" apart
- 65 days to maturity

**EGGPLANT: Black Beauty**

Solanum melongena

The eggplant standard, an heirloom. Mild, slightly sweet. 4-6 fruits per plant. Can grow in containers.

- Full sun
- Direct sow when outside night air above 60, otherwise start indoors
- Plant 1/4" deep, rows 18-24" apart
- Plant height 24-30", 24" wide
- 60 days to maturity after transplanting

KALE: Kalebration Mix

Brassica spp.

Baby kale mix in greens and purples, varied textures. Harvest and allow to regrow.

- Full sun
- Direct sow
- Plant 1/4" deep, 3-5 seeds every inch, rows 18-36" apart.
- 29 days to maturity

**LETTUCE: Tricolor Romaine Mix**

Mix of Vivian, Sylvia and Freckles romaine lettuces. Mild flavors.

- Full sun
- Direct sow in cool season
- Plant 1/8" deep, 4-16" apart
- 30-60 days to maturity

**LETTUCE: Black Seeded Simpson**

Lactuca sativa

Easy to grow green leaf lettuce; strong yields, can grow in containers. More heat-tolerant than some.

- Prefers full sun, but can bolt or wilt in strong heat
- Direct sow in cool season
- Plant 1/8" deep, 4-16" apart
- 30-60 days to maturity

**LETTUCE: Gourmet Salad Blend**

Blend of red and green leaf lettuces, great in containers.

- Full sun, but can bolt or wilt in strong heat
- Direct sow in cool season
- Plant 1/8" deep, 4-16" apart
- 30-60 days to maturity

PEA: Sugar Snap

Pisum sativum

Sweet, crisp pods. Needs trellising. Cool weather crop.

- Full/partial sun
- Plant in cool season, direct sow
- Plant 1/2-1" deep, 1-1/2-2" apart, rows 18-36"
- 58 days to maturity

**PEPPER: Early Jalapeno Chile**

Capsicum annuum

Bold flavor, medium heat, 3" long. Enjoy green or ripen to red for sweeter flavor.

- Full sun
- Start indoors and transplant
- Plant seedlings 18-24" apart
- Plant height 18-36", 12-24" wide
- 63 days to maturity after transplanting

**PEPPER: Lunchbox Mix**

Red, yellow, and orange lunchbox snack peppers, flavorful and sweet.

- Full sun
- Start indoors and transplant
- Plant seedlings 12-18" apart, rows 24-36"
- Plant height 18-24"
- 55-80 days to maturity after transplanting

**PEPPER: Shishito**

Capsicum annuum

Thin-walled, no heat, delicious roasted. 3" long.

- Full sun
- Start indoors and transplant
- Plant seedlings 12-18" apart
- 60 days to maturity

SPINACH: Equinox

Spinacia oleracea

Fast-growing, slower-bolting, harvest at baby leaf or full size.

- Full sun, can tolerate some shade
- Direct sow
- Plant 1/2" deep, 10 seeds per foot, rows 12-18" apart
- 29 days to maturity

**SQUASH: Waltham Butternut**

Cucurbita moschata

Butternut winter squash, yields 4-5 fruits per plant.

- Full sun
- Direct sow
- Plant 1/2-1" deep, 2-3 seeds per mound, rows 6-8 feet apart
- Vines are 8 feet long
- 100 days to maturity

**SQUASH: Scallop Blend Summer**

Cucurbita pepo

Yellow, white, and green blend of "patty pan" summer squashes. Good in containers.

- Full sun
- Direct sow
- Plant 1/2-1" deep, 2-3 seeds per mound, rows 3-4 feet apart
- Plant height 2 feet, 3-4 feet wide
- 45-60 days to maturity

**SQUASH: Zucchini, Black Beauty**

Cucurbita pepo

Dark-green skin and delicate white flesh; popular zucchini squash dating to the 1920s.

- Full sun
- Direct sow
- Plant 1/2-1" deep, plants 18-24" apart
- 60 days to maturity

SQUASH: Zucchini, Golden

Cucurbita pepo

Compact bush variety, medium-size zucchini. Great for small spaces.

- Full sun
- Direct sow
- Plant 1/2-1" deep, rows 18-24" apart
- 60-90 days to maturity

**SWISS CHARD: Heart of Gold**

Beta vulgaris

Green leaves, golden stems, vigorous plants and excellent yield.

- Full sun to partial shade in hot weather
- Direct sow
- Plant 1/2" deep, 6 seeds per foot, rows 12-18" apart
- 30-60 days to maturity depending on desired leaf size

**TATSOI**

Brassica rapa var. narinosa

Round, cupped green leaves with white, crunchy, juicy stems.

Full to partial sun

- Direct sow
- Plant 1/4" deep, 3-5 seeds per ", rows 2" apart
- 25-45 days to maturity depending on desired leaf size

**TOMATILLO: De Milpa**

Physalis philadelphica

Green and purple heirloom tomatillos. Store for several weeks--delicious in salsa.

- Full sun
- Sow indoors then transplant
- Plant at least two seedlings, for successful pollination and fruit set
- 70 days to maturity

TOMATO: Roma

Lycopersicum esculentum

A classic and often used as a “sauce” tomato. Mild sweetness. Determinate plant.

- Full sun
- Sow indoors 1/4-1/2” deep, then transplant
- Space plants 18-36”
- 60-90 days to maturity

**TOMATO: Sunrise Bumblebee**

Solanum lycopersicum

A yellow and red cherry tomato, very sweet with some tang. Indeterminate.

- Full sun
- Sow indoors 1/4” deep, then transplant
- Space rows 24-36” apart
- 70 days to maturity
