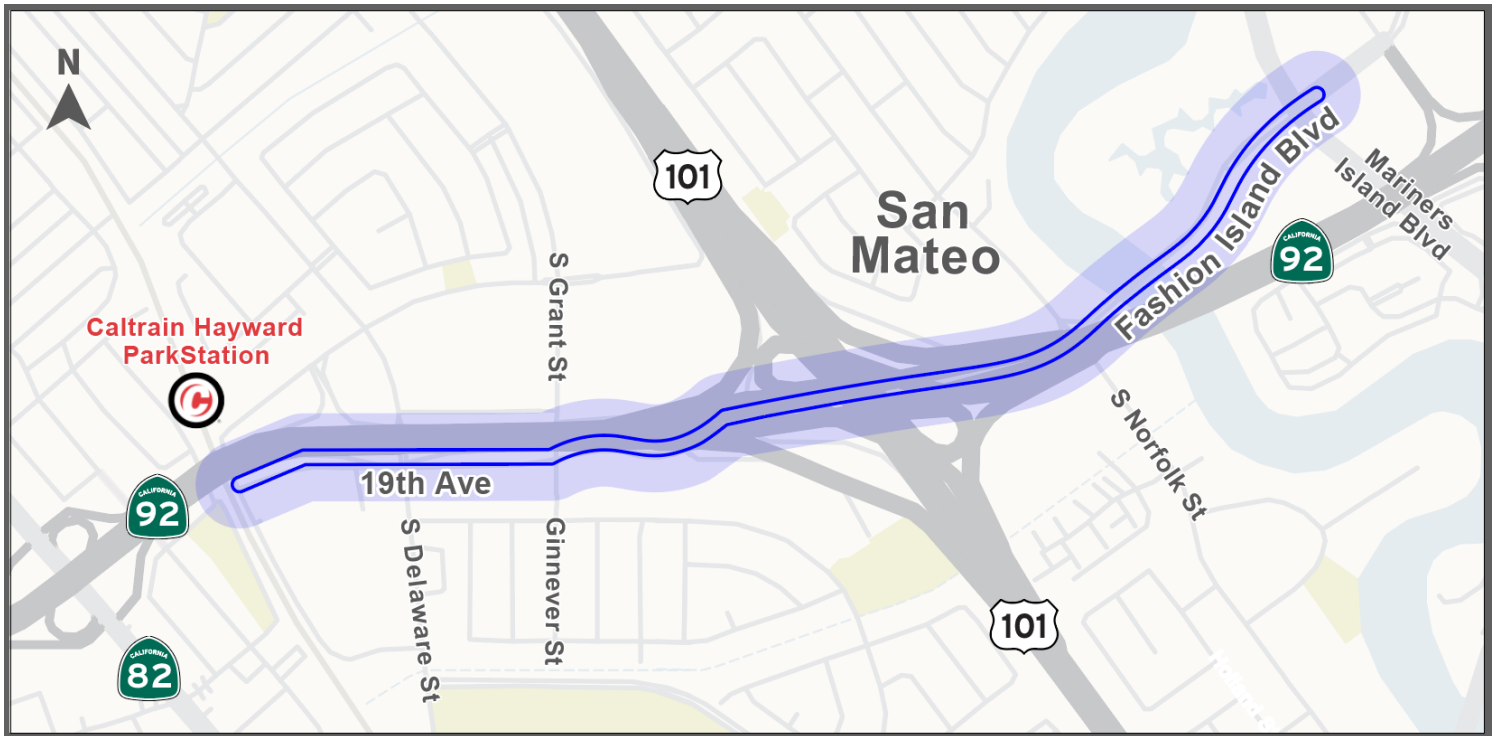
PROJECT OVERVIEW

19th Avenue and Fashion Island Boulevard are key routes serving San Mateo. This project will make the route safer and easier for everyone walking, biking, riding transit and driving the corridor. Protected bikeway and pedestrian crossing improvements will address the concerns that residents and commuters face using this route. The project will also improve the conditions at on- and off- ramps and fill in existing sidewalk and bike network gaps. The project is being led by the City of San Mateo, with funding and support from the San Mateo County Transportation Authority.

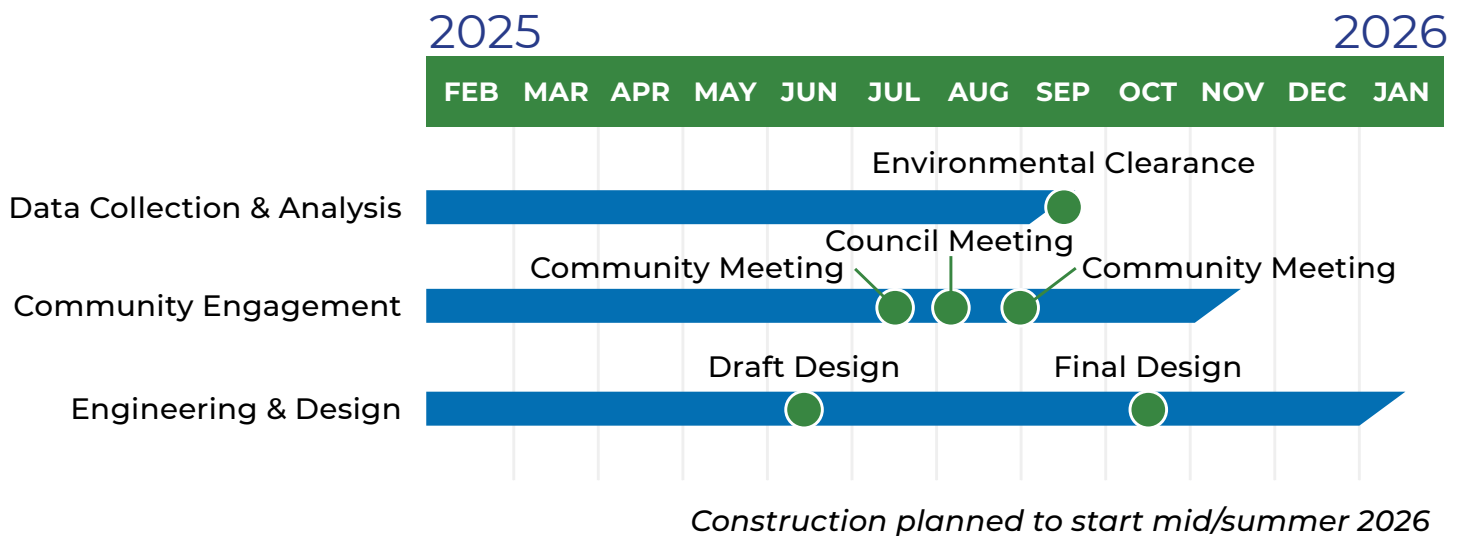
BENEFITS
